Main features:

- **Natural fibers (11,4%** from various sources including soybeanhulls, beetpulp, sunflowermeal and french alfalfa **to support rumination and prevent from acidosis;**
- **Fortified with all necessary vitamins, including:**
 - Vit A. 10.000 IE --> See also label
 - Vit D-3 1.500 IE
 - Vit E. 10 mg
- **Contains added Copper (20 mg Cu):** also suits Sheep-breeds that need Copper;
- **Also included are B-Vitamins, vegetable oils and Biotin** for a healthy fur and strong hoofs.
- **Always to be fed together with water and enough roughage.**
- High in B-Vitamins, Biotine and Vitamine E for a healthy fur.
- Allways feed together with enough roughage and water
- Packed in new paper bags (▶) 25 kilo per bag.

IMPORTANT: Acidosis in goats: a important feeding-problem!

Rumen acidosis is a carbohydrate fermentation disorder of the rumen that can affect all ruminants (goats, sheep, cows, camels) of all breeds and ages.

As the name implies, **acidosis** results in the rumen pH becoming acidic. It is mainly caused by the overfeeding of highly fermentable carbohydrates (too much grains like barley, wheat, etc.) and/or underfeeding of effective fibers. Affected animals appear depressed and may suffer severe pains. Feed-intake drops. It can result in death quickly.

Acidosis is prevented by proper feeding management and by using specialised compound feeds.

Prevention:

- * **Avoid feeding plain cereals** (barley, wheat, corn) and avoid ingredients rich in sugars (molasses);
- * Always provide roughage on a free choice basis. Animals should never run out of forages or hay.
- * Healthy goats should spend a significant portion of their time **chewing their cud**. If they are not, increase the amount of forage;
- * Use special goat-feeds, containing low levels of rapidly fermentable carbohydrates. Concentrated goat-feed should be introduced to the diet slowly.
